Saturday Morning, August 9 – Museum Tours:

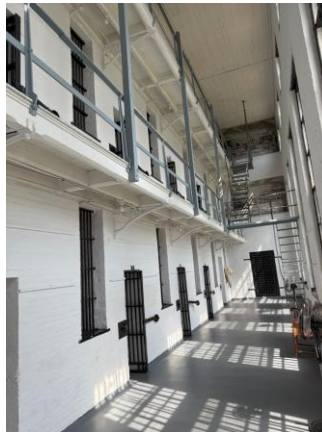
Approximately 25 classmates toured the John Brown House and the Old Jail Museum on King Street. Both serve as historical museums for Chambersburg and the surrounding area.
